PPP in First Aid

- Priorities
- Preserve life Stop the person from dying.
- Prevent further injury (worsening) stop the person from being injured even more.

Aim of First Aid

- Preserve life
- Prevent illness or injury from becoming worse
- Relieve pain if possible
- Promote recovery
- Protect the unconscious

Role of First Aider

- Assess the situation quickly and calmly. Safety check whether you or the casualty are in danger. Find out what caused the accident or situation and find out what happened?
- Protect yourself and others from any danger:
- Always protect yourself first: Never put yourself in danger. If you can't make an area safe call 999 or 112 for emergency help
- Prevent infection between you and them.
- Comfort and reassure stay calm and take change of the situation.
- Assess the casualty given first aid treatment.
